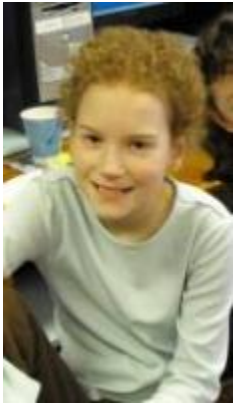


Virginia Victors
